- Have mailed out over **580 direct mailings** to industry consultants and prospects.
- Assisted with expansion of NSK Steering Systems, 180 new jobs created
- Assisted with pending expansion plans at three local industries; over 100 new potential jobs to be added.
- Met new plant managers at Caterpillar, Sara Lee, PolyOne and new CEO of Briggs & Stratton
- Have an average of 225 unique visitors to our website each day, 8,300 monthly, and 100,000 annually
- Have held 2 Industry Roundtables; held an Existing Industry Roundtable on Workers' Comp Law
- Supported the Foreign Trade Zone application process
- Two Retail Action Team meetings held, went to ICSC meeting in Louisville to recruit new retailers
