# Annual Membership Matters Luncheon

2012 Mid-Year Report August 27, 2012

#### I. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT & MARKET GROWTH

- Dyersburg was ranked among the Top 100 Micropolitan areas in the March issue of Site Selection,
   We are ranked tops in West Tennessee for Economic Development.
- We have worked on 10 new industrial projects so far this year and have had site visits by several
  companies interested in locating a facility in Dyersburg.
- We assisted with pending expansion plans at three local industries; over 100 new potential jobs to be added.
- The Chamber has an average of 228 unique visitors to our website each day, 7,250 monthly, and 87,000 annually.
- Our Existing Industry group has held 1 Industry Roundtable at PolyOne so far this year.
- We supported the Foreign Trade Zone application process which is now near completion.
- One Retail Action Team meeting was held; went to ICSC meeting in Nashville to recruit new retailers
- We held the 2012 Industry Appreciation Golf Tournament on May 11th with an upturn in participation and sponsorship.
- We held the 2012 Industry Appreciation Cookout in May with Arnold Perl as the speaker.
- Continue to support and promote the development of the Port at Cates Landing; have held eight meetings to assist
- Started process of the Select TN Certified Sites Program to certify two industrial sites.
- Traveled to Atlanta, Austin, Nashville, to promote Dyersburg/Dyer County and meet with various site selection consultants and other economic development professionals

### **II. REGIONAL ADVOCACY & COMMUNITY INITIATIVES**

- Maintained accreditation in the TN Three Star program by meeting requirements for Benchmark II
- Hosted annual West Star session on Education
- TEP Phase II/III is ending with the completion of the downtown Dyersburg streetscape project. New
  period appropriate lighting is ordered and should complete the project on schedule. The
  communications plan involving the merchants, engineering, construction, Main Street and the City of
  Dyersburg was successful.
- In the second season of the Main Street Farmers Market, growers only format, customers and growers increased. Actual profits are near the predicted 10% increase. The first Certified Domestic Kitchen baker joined the growers this season.
- Continuing to partner with the Dyer County YMCA and Y-USA for the Pioneering Healthy Communities to advocate for healthier lifestyles
- Have held 107 events at The Lannom Center thus far
- Renewed the biannual contract with City of Dyersburg for Tourism & Economic Development
- Retained accreditation in the U.S. Chamber of Commerce
- Staff members Hester and Hall served as instructors for the TN Chamber Institute
- Dyer County Adult Leadership held graduation for 13 new community leaders; Dyer County Youth Leadership graduated 39 tenth graders
- Supported efforts of Mississippi River Corridor Tennessee Chapter
- Provided funding for Big River Bowl, Halls Air Show, The Big Deal, Hoopfest, Duckfest
- Held a Legislative coffee which was attended by about 100 people
- Held a Community coffee on March 9, where Mayor Holden gave a presentation of the "State of the City"
- 3rd Annual Duckfest broke previous attendance and vendor records. A record number of attendees registered for the TWRA Blind Drawing in Tigrett.
- The Agribusiness Committee has met two times this year. Lobbied members of Congress with letters addressing trade issues.

#### III. BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT & COMMUNICATIONS

- Retained our memberships and participation in the International Economic Development Council, Southern Economic Development Council, Industrial Asset Management Council, TN Economic Partnership and International Council of Shopping Centers, as well as the American Chamber of Commerce Executives, TN Chamber of Commerce Executives and TN Chamber of Commerce & Industry; Dyersburg's Chamber CEO is president-elect of the TCCE.
- Annual **Destination** publication was published in June.
- Held five Ribbon Cuttings thus far with assistance from our Diplomats, Mayors, and other dignitaries.
- Held 8 12@12 luncheons for Chamber and prospective members to learn about current programs and member benefits.
- Continue a bi-weekly "At Work" News Brief to keep members informed on important Chamber news and events.
- Held the 2012 Business Expo on May 24th with record attendance and 56 vendors
- Print advertising done in Site Selection, Area Development and Business Facilities magazine, as well as State Gazette.
- Received new retail marketing materials from Shopping Center Group
- Purchased a mobile phone app for our members
- Held a Business After Hours at Professional Realty Group's new office
