

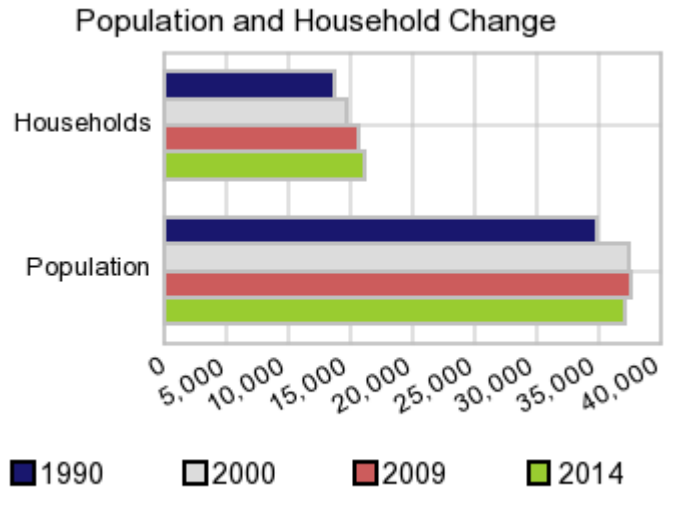

Population Demographics

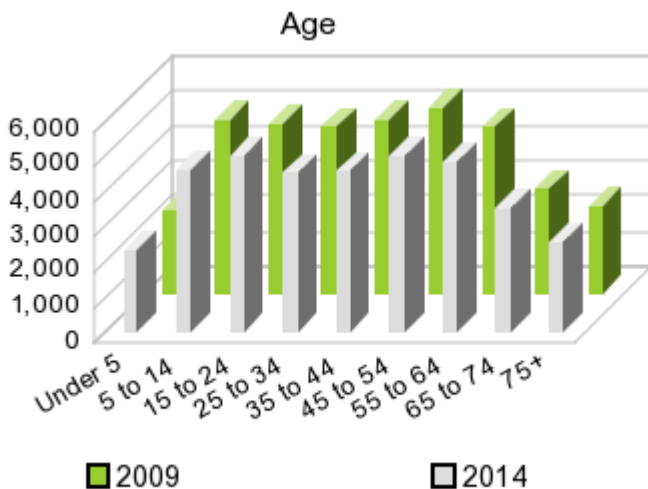
The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **13,617** and changed to **14,751** in 2000, representing a change of **8.3%**. The household count in 2009 was **15,644** and the household projection for 2014 is **16,168**, a change of **3.4%**.

The population in the study area in 1990 was **34,853** and in 2000 it was **37,279**, roughly a **7.0%** change. The population in 2009 was **37,471** and the projection for 2014 is **37,081** representing a change of **-1.0%**.

Population by Age



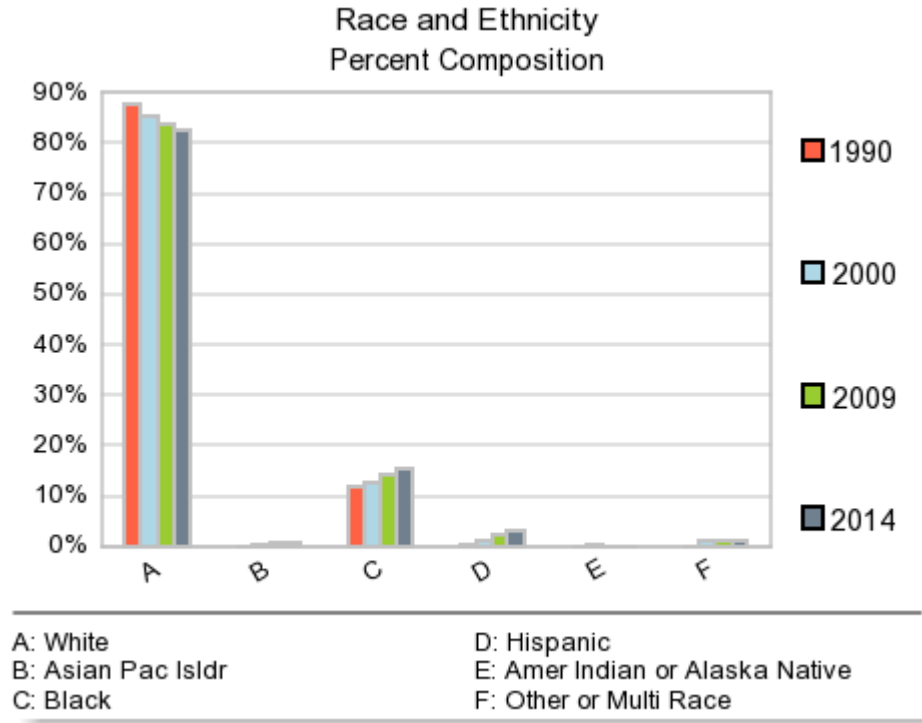
In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was **34.4**, and in 2000, it was **36.500000**. The median age in 2009 is **38.7** and it is predicted to change in five years to **39.4** years. In 2009, females represented **51.9%** of the population with a median age of **40.1** and males represented **48.1%** of the population with a median age of **37.1** years. In 2009, the most prominent age group in this geography is **Age 45 to 54** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **18 to 24** years.

Population by Race/Ethnicity



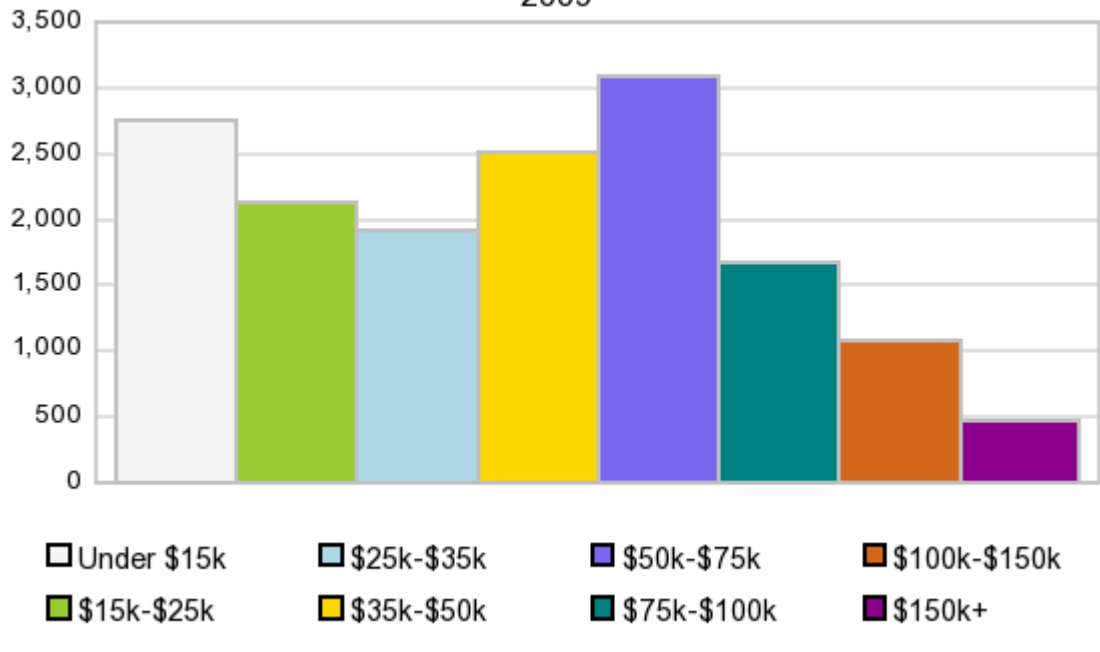
In 2009, the predominant race/ethnicity category in this study area is **White**. The race & ethnicity category least represented in this geography is **American Indian, Alaska Native**.
